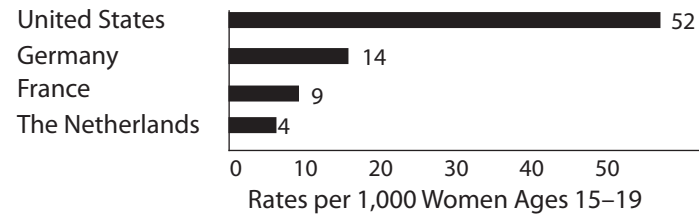


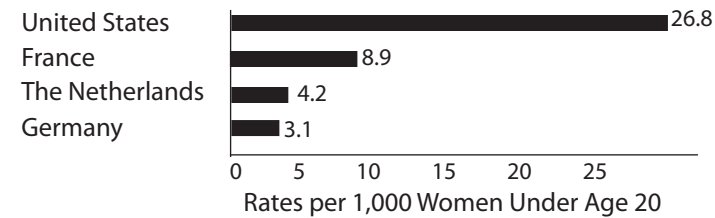

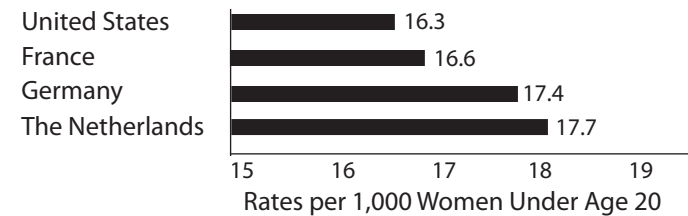
Teen Birth Rate
